JUL 6, 2010: OVERNIGHT FLIGHT Depart from the USA.

JUL 7, 2010: LONDON Arrive in London, the theater capital of the world. (D)

JUL 8, 2010: LONDON Morning sightseeing shows you Trafalgar Square, St. Paul's Cathedral, the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben. The afternoon is free for a visit to the Tower of London. (B,D)

JUL 9, 2010: PARIS Depart England's capital for a journey across the English Channel aboard the Eurostar. In just over two hours you arrive in the City of Light, Paris. This afternoon, sightseeing shows you Notre Dame and the Arc de Triomphe. (B,D)

JUL 10, 2010: PARIS In the morning there is an optional excursion to Claude Monet's home in Giverny, open April 1. Explore the beautiful gardens and lily ponds that inspired his famous water lily paintings. This afternoon use your ACIS Walking Tour to discover the beautiful Louvre. Enjoy an optional Le Train Bleu dinner with an illumination drive of Paris. (B,D)

JUL 11, 2010: OVERNIGHT TRAIN After a free morning, an excursion to Louis XIV's palace at Versailles includes the Hall of Mirrors. This evening, board an overnight train to Nice, four-berth couchettes provided. (B,D)

Passports

Passports are required for all ACIS trips traveling abroad. You are responsible for obtaining your own passport so please don't delay! Visit your post office or a local office of the federal government for an application form. Note that some countries require that passports be valid for six months after you return to the United States. Please be sure that yours is up to date.
